All Mirnesots homes can have dangarous levels of mules gam in them. Radon is a colorless, adorless and tastaless redissective gas that can easy into homes from the earth. When inheled, its redissective particles can demage the calls that line the lungs, Long-term exposure to redon can lead to lung quantum. About 21,000 iung cancer deaths each year in the Linted States are called by radon, making it a serious health concern for all Mirnesotors.

It does not matter if the loans is old or now and the only way to know how much redon gas has entered the home is to conduct a redon test, MDH actimates 2 in II homes built before 2018 and 1 in 5 homes built since 2018 and 2018 exceed the 4.0 pCM, action level.



In Minnesote, buyers and seliers in a real estate transaction are free to negotiate radon testing and reduction. Likimetely, it is up to the buyer to decide an acceptable level of radon risk in the home. Prospective buyers should keep in mind that it is inexpendive and seay to measure radon, and radon levels can be lowered at a reseasable cost. The MDH Radon Program website provides more detailed information on radon, including the MDH brochure "Kasping Your Home Safe from Radon."

The Minnesota Radon Awaranees Act does not require radon testing or mitigation. However, many relocation companies and lending institutions, as well as home buyers, require a radon test when purchasing a house. The purpose of this publication is to advante and inform potential home buyers of the risks of radon exposure, and how to test for and reduce radon as part of real estate transposions.



Disclosure Requirements

Effective January 1, 2014, the Minnesote Redon Awarenese Act requires specific disclosure and aducation be provided to potential home buyers during residential real estate transactions in Minnesote. This publication is being provided by the salar in order to meet a requirement of the Act. In addition, before algulary purchase agreement to sell or transfer residential real property, the seller shall disclose in writing to the buyer any knowledge the salar has of radon concentrations in the dwelling.

The disolosure shall include:

- 1. whether a radon test or tests have occurred on the property:
- the most current records and reports pertaining to redon concentrations within the dwalling;
- a description of any radon aonoentrations, mitigation, or remediation;
- Information regarding the redon mitigation system, inolating system description and documentation, if such system has been installed in the dwelling; and
- 5. a radon warning statement

Baden Marring Statement

"The Minnesota Department of Health strongly recommends that ALL homebuyers have an indoor radon test performed prior to purchase or taking company, and recommends having the radon levels mitigated if elevated radon concentrations are found. Elevated radon concentrations can easily be raduced by a qualified, certified, or licensed, if applicable, radon mitigator.

Every buyer of any interest in residential real property is notified that the property may present exposure to dangerous levels of indoor radon gas that may place the occupents at risk of developing radon-induced king cencer. Radon, a Class A human carcinogen, is the leading cause of lung cencer in nonemotiers and the second leading cause overall. The seller of any interest in realdential real property is required to provide the buyer with any information on radon test results of the dwelling."

It is recommended all new homes be tested for radon, and if eleveted levels are found, these peasive RANC features can be easily and inexpensively activated with the addition of a radon fan in the attic. If you are buying a new home, ask if the home has any RANC features and if the home has been tested.

What is the recommended action keeps on my regular?

If the average reidon in the home is at or allows \$1.0 pCi/L, thu bouse should be fixed. Consider fixing the home if redon levels are between 2 pCi/L and S.S. pCi/L. The test idt should be pleast:

- two to six feet above the floor
- at least three fast from exterior wells
- four inches sway from other objects
- in a kastion where it won't be disturbed
- not in enclosed errors
- not in areas of high heat or lumidity

If the house has multiple foundation types, it is recommended that each of these be tested. For instance, if the house has one or more of the following foundation types—basement, crewl space, sist-ongrade—a test should be performed in the beamment and in at least one room over the crewlapsed and one room with a alph-ongrade area.

Who should conduct realize heating in real action transactions?

All redon tests should be conducted in accordance with nedonal redon measurement protocols, by a certified and MDH-listed professional. This ensures the test was conducted properly, in the correct location, and under appropriate building conditions. A list of these redon measurement professionals can be found at MDH's Redon web site. A celler may have previously conducted testing in a property. If the test result is at or above the action level, the home should be mitigated.

Radon mitigation is the process or system used to reduce radon concentrations in the breathing zones of occupied buildings. The goal of a radon mitigation system is to raduce the indoor radon levels to below the EPA action level of 4.0 pG/L. A quality radon raduction [mitigation] system is often able to radons the ennual average radon level to below 2.0 pG/L.

Active sub-sleb suction (elso called sub-sleb depressurization, or SSD) is the most common and usually the most reliable type of system because it draws redon-filled air from beneath the house and vents it outside. There are standards of practice that need to be followed for the installation of these systems. More information on radion mitigation can be found at the MDH Clarkov website.
