Attachment to Sellers Disclosure Statement (40 Clay Cliffe Drive)

- ~ There is a dying tree just off the pool deck. I do not believe the tree is diseased.
- ~ There are various (very few) landscape plantings that are not in good health and may need to be removed or replaced.
- ~ There is Milfoil in the area around the dock. I have been using a lakeshore restoration company to control the weeds at a cost of around \$1,500 per year. The Milfoil absolutely is not an issue for boating, fishing or swimming in and around the dock if proper steps are taken to control the weeds.
- \sim There are several pieces of art hanging on wooden walls. The wood around the art has darkened over time due to exposure to light. When these pieces of art are removed, there will be an area on the wall that is lighter in color than the surround. These areas should darken over time.
- \sim The ceiling speakers in the master bathroom "crackle" when the music is played loud. These speakers may need to be replaced.
- \sim There are several large cracks/chunks in the concrete between the driveway and garage threshold.
- ~ There is 1 window that needs to be replaced due to moisture in the windows. This windows are under warranty from Andersen Windows are scheduled to be replaced this winter.
- ~ There is minor water damage around the corners of some windows due to condesation. More significant water damage to the trim around one window in the billiards room (window was left open during snow).
- ~ There will be a large bare area in the back yard when the play system is removed.
- ~ There is small tear in the pool cover that will need to be repaired.
- ~ The automatic sky light window opener in the master bath does not work.
