317. 318. 319.		In addition to the possible structural damage water intrusion may do to the property, water intrusion may also result in the growth of mold, mildew and other fungl. Mold growth may also cause structural damage to the property. Therefore, it is very important to detect and remediate water intrusion problems.
320. 321. 322. 323.		Fungi are present everywhere in our environment, both indoors and outdoors. Many molds are beneficial to humans. However, molds have the ability to produce mycotoxins that may have a potential to cause serious health problems, particularly in some immunocompromised individuals and people who have asthma or allergies to mold.
324. 325. 326. 327. 328.		To complicate matters, mold growth is often difficult to detect, as it frequently grows within the wall structure. If you have a concern about water intrusion or the resulting mold/mildew/fungi growth, you may want to consider having the property inspected for moisture problems before entering into a purchase agreement or as a condition of your purchase agreement. Such an analysis is particularly advisable if you observe staining or musty odors on the property.

Radon: Real Estate Transactions



All Minnesota homes can have dengarous levels of **realize gas** in them. Radon is a colorless, adorless and tasteless **realizactive** gas that can seep into homes from the earth. When inheled, its radioactive particles can deniage the calls that line the tangs. Long-term exposure to redon can lead to **lineg** cancer. About 21,000 lang cancer deaths each year in the United States are caused by redon, making it a serious health concern for all Minnesotans.

It does not maiter if the bome is all at norm and the only way to know how much radon pas has entered the home is to conduct a radon tast. MDH estimates 2 to 5 homes built before 2018 and 1 is 5 homes built since 2018 exceed the 4,0 pCN, action level.



In Minnesota, buyers and sellers in a real estate transaction are free to negotiate radon testing and reduction. Ultimately, it is up to the buyer to decide an acceptable level of radon risk in the home, Prospective buyers should keep in mind that it is inexpensive and easy to measure radon, and radon levels can be lowered at a reasonable cost. The MDH Radon Program website provides more detailed information on radon, including the MDH brochure "Keeping Your Home Safe from Radon."

The Minneeota Radon Awareness Act does not require redon testing or mitigation. However, meny relocation companies and lending institutions, as well as home buyers, require a radon test when purchasing a house. The purpose of this publication is to educate and inform potential home buyers of the risks of radon exposure, and how to test for and reduce radon as part of real estate transactions.



Disclosure Requirements

Effective January 1, 2014, the Minnesota Radon Awareness Act requires specific disolosure and education be provided to potential home buyers during residential real estate transactions in Minnesota. This publication is being provided by the seller in order to meet a requirement of the Act. In addition, before signing a parchase agreement to sell ar transfer residential real property, the seller shall disclose in writing to the buyer any knowledge the seller has of redon concentrations in the dwelling.

The disclosure shall include:

- whether a radon test or tests have occurred on the property;
- the most current records and reports partishing to rade: concentrations within the dwalfing;
- a description of any redon concentrations, mitigation, or remediation;
- Information regarding the radon mitigation system, including eyetem description and documentation, if such system has been installed in the dwelling, and
- 5. a radon warning statement

"The Minnesota Department of Health strongly recommends that ALL homebuyers have an Indoor redon test performed prior to purchase or taking occupancy, and recommends having the radion levels mitigated if elevated radion concentrations are found. Every buyer of any interest in residential real property is notified that the property may present apposure to dangerous levels of indoor radon gas that may place this occupants at risk of developing radon-induced lung cancer. Padon, a Cleas A human carchagen, is the leading cause of lung cancer in nonamoleurs and the second leading cause overall. The seller of any interest in residential real property is required to provide the buyer with any information on radon test results of the dwelling."

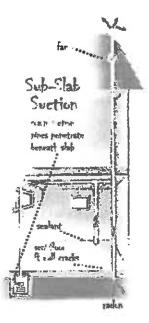

- at least three feet from exterior walls
- four inches away from other objects
- in a location where it won't be disturbed
- not in enclosed eress
- not in areas of high heat or humidity

If the house has multiple foundation types, it is recommended that each of these be tested. For instance, if the house has one or more of the following foundation types—basement, creed space, sleb-ongrade—a test should be performed in the basement and in at least one room over the crawlapace and one room with a slab-on-crade area.

The should constact rades testing in real estate transactions?

All redon tests should be conducted in accordance with national redon measurement protocols, by a certified and MDH-listed professional. This ensures the test was conducted properly, in the correct jocation, and under appropriate building conditions. A list of these redon measurement professionals can be found at MDH's Redon web site. A seller may have previously conducted testing in a property. If the test result is at or above the action level, the home should be mitigated.



Radon Mitigation

Lawering radou in existing homes - Radon Mitigation

When elevated levels of recion are found, they should be mitigated. Elevated radon concentrations can be easily reduced by a nationally certified and MDH-listed redon mitigation professionals. A list of these redon mitigation professionals can be found at MDH's Radon web site.

Redon mitigation is the process or system used to reduce redon concentrations in the breathing zones of occupied buildings. The goal of a radon mitigation system is to reduce the indoor radon levels to below the EPA action level of 4.0 pCi/L. A quality radon reduction (mitigation) system is often able to reduce the ennual everage radon level to below 2.0 pCi/L.

Active sub-sleb suction (also called sub-sleb depressurization, or SSD) is the most common and usually the most reliable type of system because it draws redon-filled air from beneath the house and vents it outside.
