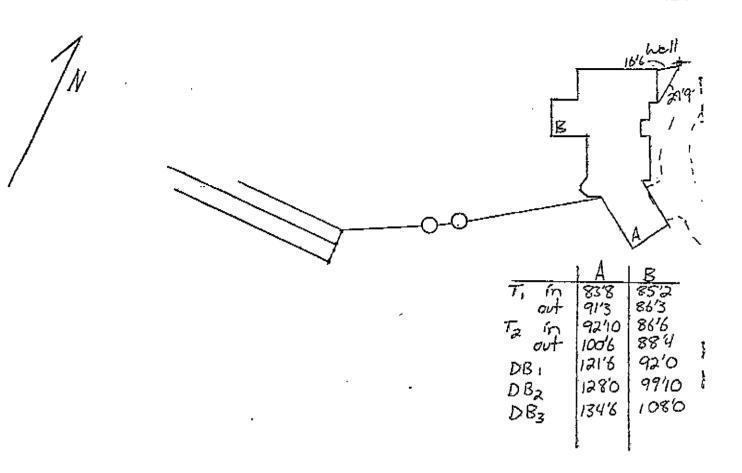

Disclosure Supplement 1510 Green Trees Road, Wayzata, MN 55391

On December 9, 2010 Certified Moisture Testing, LLC (CMY) performed a whole home Moisture Test and Analysis on the stucco wall surfaces on the property at 1510 Green Trees Road, Wayzata, MN. The Moisture Test and Analysis report outlined specific areas that required repairs for moisture intrusion and water diversion.

In July 2011, Hunerberg Construction Company was contracted to make the recommended water intrusion repairs outlined in the CMT report. The work was performed and completed with permits and inspections by the City of Orono.

As Hunerberg Construction employees were performing the repairs around the Sun Room windows, they discovered that the Sun Room roof had some dmaged wood and the membrane was in need of replacement.

Per the September 17, 2011 invoice, Gary Benson Construction replaced damaged roof rafters and all of the plywood surface and installed a new roof membrane and flashing. This work is covered by a five year warranty.
